

Hire Leeward Job and Career Fair

Connecting employers with job seekers

For the fourth year in a row, the Annual Hire Leeward Job and Career Fair will connect prospective employees with jobs that are closer to home. This year's fair will have about 70 Leeward and West O'ahu businesses and organizations that are looking for new hires. The range of industries is wide — including healthcare, food service, hospitality, retail, military, and administrative, as well as trade apprenticeships. The fair will take place on Saturday, June 25 and will run from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the campus of host sponsor, the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu.

The job fair is presented by Councilmember Kymberly Marcos Pine in partnership with the Kapolei Chamber of Commerce.

The event will be of special interest to folks who are interested in job opportunities at Ka Makana Ali'i, the new 1.4 million-square-foot regional mall that is scheduled to open this fall. "We are delighted to open our doors and share the beauty of O'ahu's west coast with visitors from here and around the world," said Hulugalle.

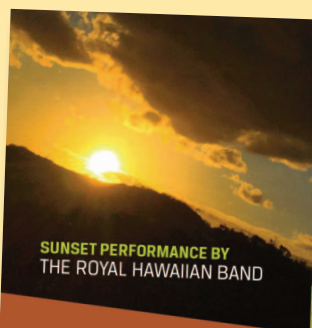
